From place other than where speaker is

I go – Nuttom You go – Kuttom (He) goes – Oom We go – Kutomun They went – Oomwog

I go to my people – Nuttom Nummissinninneumut I shall go to him - Pish Nuttom Wuhhogkat

From the place where the speaker is

I go - Nummoncheem You go - Kummoncheem (He) goes - Monchu We go - Nummonchumun I went - Nummonchip Go (imper.) - Monchish

To go with or accompany

Go with him – wechau
He went with them – ooweechauoh
They went with him – ooweechauouh
I go with you – Kooweechaush
He went with him – weechauau
I go down with you – Kooweeche Woomseumsh
He was with me – Noh Weechiyeumuk

Other forms

You go to – Ongk Go away – Amaish To depart – Amaenat I go, depart – Nuttamaeen

He goes out of the way, goes wrong – Panneau
He goes astray, wanders – Wauonu
He goes to and fro – Aohsuhqueau
He goes below, under it – agushau
